SEE THE BELLS OF ST LEONARD'S, NAREMBURN



Would you like to visit the bell tower of St Leonard's church, Naremburn for a guided tour to see our beautiful bells? Originally from a church in Wales, UK, these bells were cast in 1866 and retuned in Loughborough, UK in 2012, from where they were shipped to Australia. Installing the bells in St Leonard's church began in January 2013 and was completed in April 2013.

As part of our **Australia Day** celebrations, we are offering two free tours of the tower, the **first commencing at 3 pm, the second at 4 pm on Friday 26th January 2018**. Please arrive promptly at the back of the church (corner Willoughby and Donnelly Roads) at **5 minutes to the hour**. Tours are expected to last about 45 minutes.
